The complainant stated that voters were being turned away at the Comer Precinct on Election Day and that anyone with a Comer address was eligible to vote. Ms. Dean explained to the investigator that this was a municipal election and only those voters who lived within the city limits were eligible to vote in the municipal election. The SOS investigator understood.
