## **Chairperson's Report**

Monthly stats have not changed since last month due to voter registration cut-off date.

An investigator from the SOS office spoke with Ms. Dean concerning a complaint of voter fraud. The complaint alleged that all voters with a Comer, GA address were not being allowed to vote. Ms. Dean explained to the investigator that Advance Voting had not yet begun and only those voters who lived inside the city limits of Comer were allowed to vote in the city's election. She used herself as an example in that she has a Comer address but lives outside the city limits therefore, she is not eligible to vote in the city's election. There were no county wide elections for Madison County. The investigator understood and no further action was needed.

The same person called again on Election Day stating the same complaint. He complained the poll manager was not looking voters up on Poll Pad to confirm that they did not live in the city limits. Ms. Dean spoke with the poll manager and she stated that was not true. They were confirming every voter in the Poll Pad. This was told to complainant and he was welcome to have those who were complaining to him to go back to polling location and have the manager to confirm their eligibility. He said he would send them back there, about 20 voters, however poll manager stated no one ever came back. He stated the SOS gave him code sections that stated all Comer addresses could vote in the city election. However, he could not give the code sections so that the BOER could confirm this. He asked for code section that stated only those who lived in the city limit could vote in city election. He was told we would contact the county attorney and he could call us back. He did not call back for this information.

Election Day was going smoothly. Very low turn-out.
