She also explained why the BOER chose to end the contract with the elections. The main reason was the extra workload and staff compensation and not because of anything with the city itself. She expressed her desire to work with the cities and to hear any suggestions that could be helpful. One of the city clerks asked if a contract could be drawn up between the city and the staff so that the staff gets paid directly from the city. It was also asked if Ms. Dean could check with the county attorney to see if this was an option. Ms. Dean stated she would check with the attorney and let them know. No city elections are scheduled for 2022 so that will give time to look at options. After further discussion, most cities wanted the BOER to continue conducting their elections and would help in any way.
