Chairperson Tracy Dean called in to order the regular meeting of the Madison County Board of Elections and Registration at 5:30 p.m., June 2, 2020, via Zoom.

OLD BUSINESS:

Item No. 1. Approval of Minutes

Minutes of May 5, 2020.

With no additions or corrections to the minutes, the minutes stand.

Item No. 2. Chairperson's Report

Ms. Dean has received necessary paperwork from SOS for Mr. Nathan Owens. Probate Judge Cody Cross will administer his oath in the next few days.

Absentee Ballot applications received is 5481. Returned ballots total almost 3200. Cancelled ballots total 170. Early voting has been slow. The BOER office began mailing absentee ballots on May 26, 2020.

Scanning Absentee Ballots will begin June 4, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. according to the new SEB ruling. Tabulation will not take place until after 7:00 p.m. on June 9, 2020. The scanning process is open to monitors and observers in a designated area after signing an oath.

Ms. Scott will contact Mr. Jimmy Byrd to confirm if he will be available on Election Night to be part of the Vote Review Team. If not, Ms. Scott will have the Democratic Party to select another person.

Equipment will be deployed to the precincts on June 5, 2020, and June 8, 2020.

All precincts will be open. Poll workers will be provided with PPE equipment to use after each voter.

Managers will pick up supplies June 8, 2020, and get last minute instructions.

A link was sent to all poll workers to view SOS training videos and complete an assessment to be sent back to Ms. Dean.

Ms. Scott inquired about the Colbert polling place location. It will continue to be at the Colbert Depot for June and August run off. Precincts of Colbert, Comer and Fork will possibly move beginning in the November General Election. No public hearing is required to move a polling location.

Ms. Dean invited board members to come on June 9, 2020, to observe the scanning process.


