Chairperson Tracy Dean called in to order the regular meeting of the Madison County Board of Elections and Registration at 5:30 p.m., September 4, 2018, in the Board of Elections and Registration office located at 94 Spring Lake Dr., Danielsville, GA.

OLD BUSINESS:

Item No. 1. Approval of Minutes

Minutes of August 7, 2018. Minutes have been distributed.

Item No. 2. Chairperson's Report

All registration updates that needed to be held until after the July 24, 2018, Runoff are now complete.

The City of Comer will not hold an election this year. They will have a Special Election in 2019. The City of Hull did not have anyone to qualify; therefore, they will also have a Special Election in 2019.

Ms. Dean will have a meeting with all the city clerks after the November 6, 2018, election.

The deadline to register to vote is October 9, 2018. This deadline has been published in the legal organ.

Logic and Accuracy testing began today and will continue through the next few weeks.

Ballots have been proofed and sent back to SOS. Ballots have also been ordered.

The earliest we can mail ballots is September 18, 2018. All UOCAVA must be mailed by September 22, 2018.

Early voting begins October 15-November 2, 2018. There will also be Saturday voting on October 27, 2018.

Poll worker training will be the last week of September.

Ms. Dean received a letter from a Georgia group stating they would be watching to make sure precincts were not changed before November. Ms. Dean stated no precincts would be changed this year.

Ms. Dean asked if the board members would talk to their party members and have them ask county commissioners to have a sign placed at the end of Rock Quarry Rd. on Highway 29. She has spoken with some of the commissioners who said they would look in to it but she still has no answer. Her next step is to go to the BOC meeting or contact our state representative. There have been voter complaints about not being able to find the office and she wants all voters to be able to find us easily.
