The new Absentee Ballot Application portal is now active through the SOS. Voters may visit the SOS website to complete the application to receive a ballot by mail.

Ballots for the November election have been received. SOS will mail ballots beginning September 18, 2020.

Voter registration deadline is October 5, 2020. Early voting begins October 10, 2020.

Poll worker training will begin in the next two weeks.

PPE arrived from the SOS. SOS will possibly be sending plexiglass dividers to go between each voting unit.

The City of Hull wants to have a special election to run in conjunction with the November election to fill a vacant council seat. Ms. Dean has spoken with Mayor Paul Walton and stated to him the deadlines to have anything placed on the November ballots has passed but she would look to see if there are other options for the City of Hull to conduct an election in November.

OLD BUSINESS:

Poca and Hull polling locations will stay the same for the November election.

Fork (Carlton), Colbert and Comer will move to their new locations for November. Ms. Dean has placed an ad in the legal organ to run for two weeks and will place an ad again two weeks before the November election. New precinct cards for these locations have been ordered.

Opening and scanning of absentee ballots will begin October 26, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.
